


- Donkeys were probably among the most miserable creatures that ever lived on earth since biblical times (in my view).




VICTIMS OF....

- ► This is worsened by little interest from the public sector to promote good welfare, health and husbandry practices.
- This made the life of a donkey particularly harsh not only the way they live but also the way the die.

THE OTHER SIDE

- Successful by magnifying a "traditional myth" that gives meaning and making fortune out of this -described as "One of the three treasures of Traditional Chinese Medicine"-TCM- extremely dense and powerful story.
- Organized a network of wealthy and poor customersconsumers-the "Consumer Knows Best"
- Are we defeated? -21st C. science has made this myth probably more potent. With money, powerful corporations, has made this web of story to grow from strength to strength.

CHANGE THE STORY?

- Why we failed to simply replace this myth with the plenty of facts we have?— "TCM-has no benefits as described...."
- Why increasing the glory of fictional stories "TCM" instead of bettering the lives of suffering animals?
- It seems as corporations accumulate power/money, they become immune to their mistakes, instead of changing their stories to fit reality, they can change reality to fit their stories.
- ► They are able to force their myth on submissive reality judge themselves by the yardstick of their own inventions.



"WHO SUFFERS?"

- When we forget that these are just merely fictions, we lose touch with reality- we forget the suffering of real entities?
 - Ethiopia, Kenya, politicians, corporations and consumers will not suffer the donkey for sure suffers
