 - Better data – Better decisions – Better lives



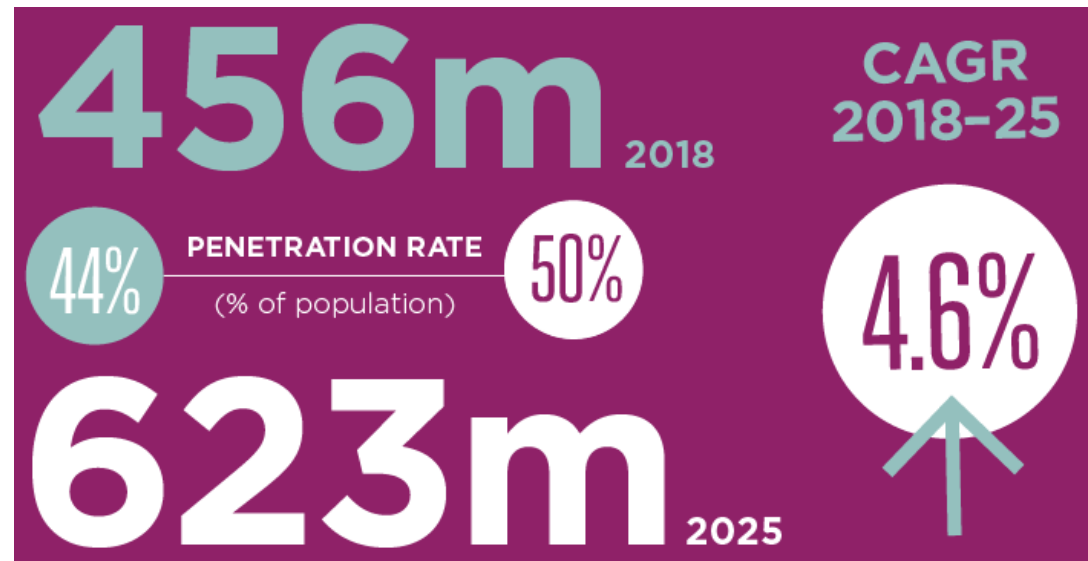

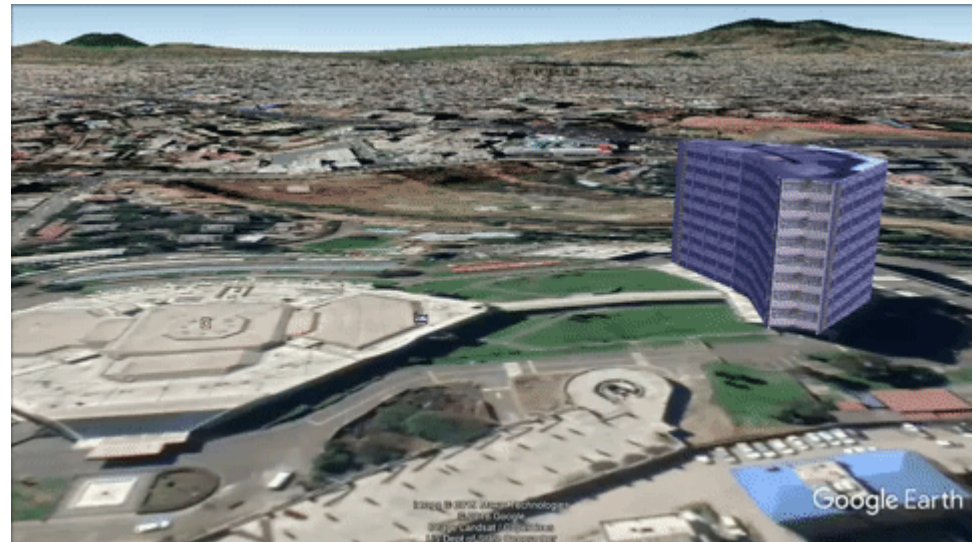
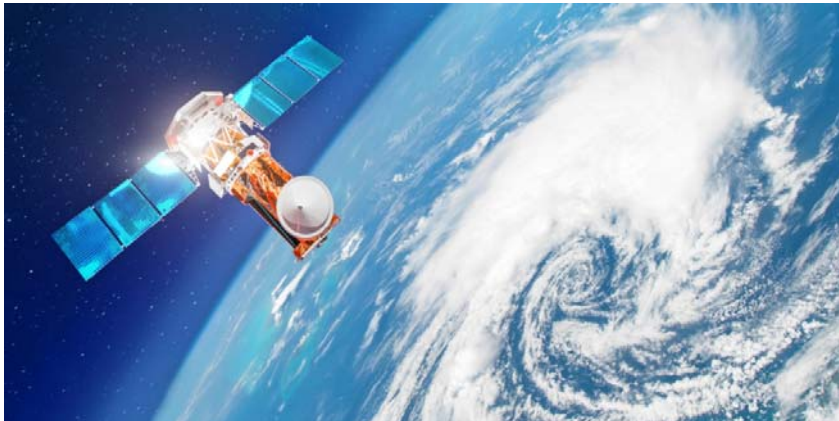


INTRODUCTION

 - Environment

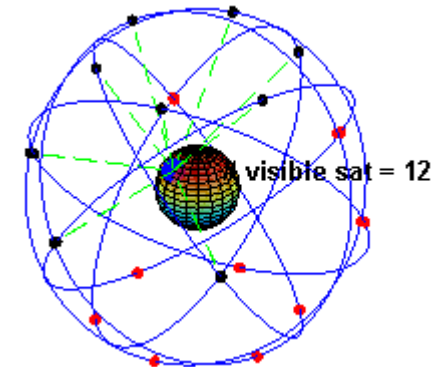


A REVIEW OF SPACE TECHNOLOGY



Three key technological domains

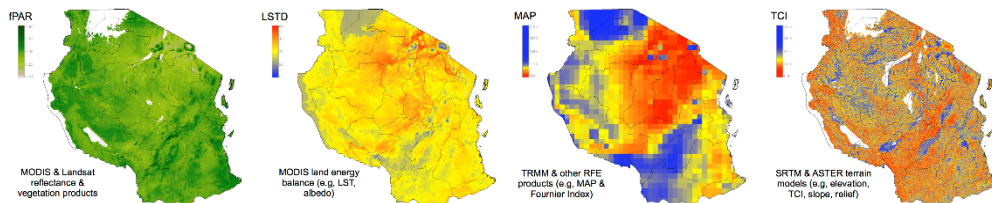
- Remote sensing
- Global Navigation Satellite Systems
- Satellite communications



TDS and SPACE TECHNOLOGY



- Using GPS to geotag animal welfare assessments and track movements
- Earth Observation (EO) used to gain additional data for ground points collected during survey
- Developing proxies from EO data linking people, environment and welfare



CONCLUSIONS AND DISCUSSION



- Huge potential to help understand relationships in complex situations
- Being used now for geospatial analysis of animal, human and environmental factors - integration
- Resources needed to maximise potential for future – skills and sensor development
- Animal welfare needs to be part of the conversation
